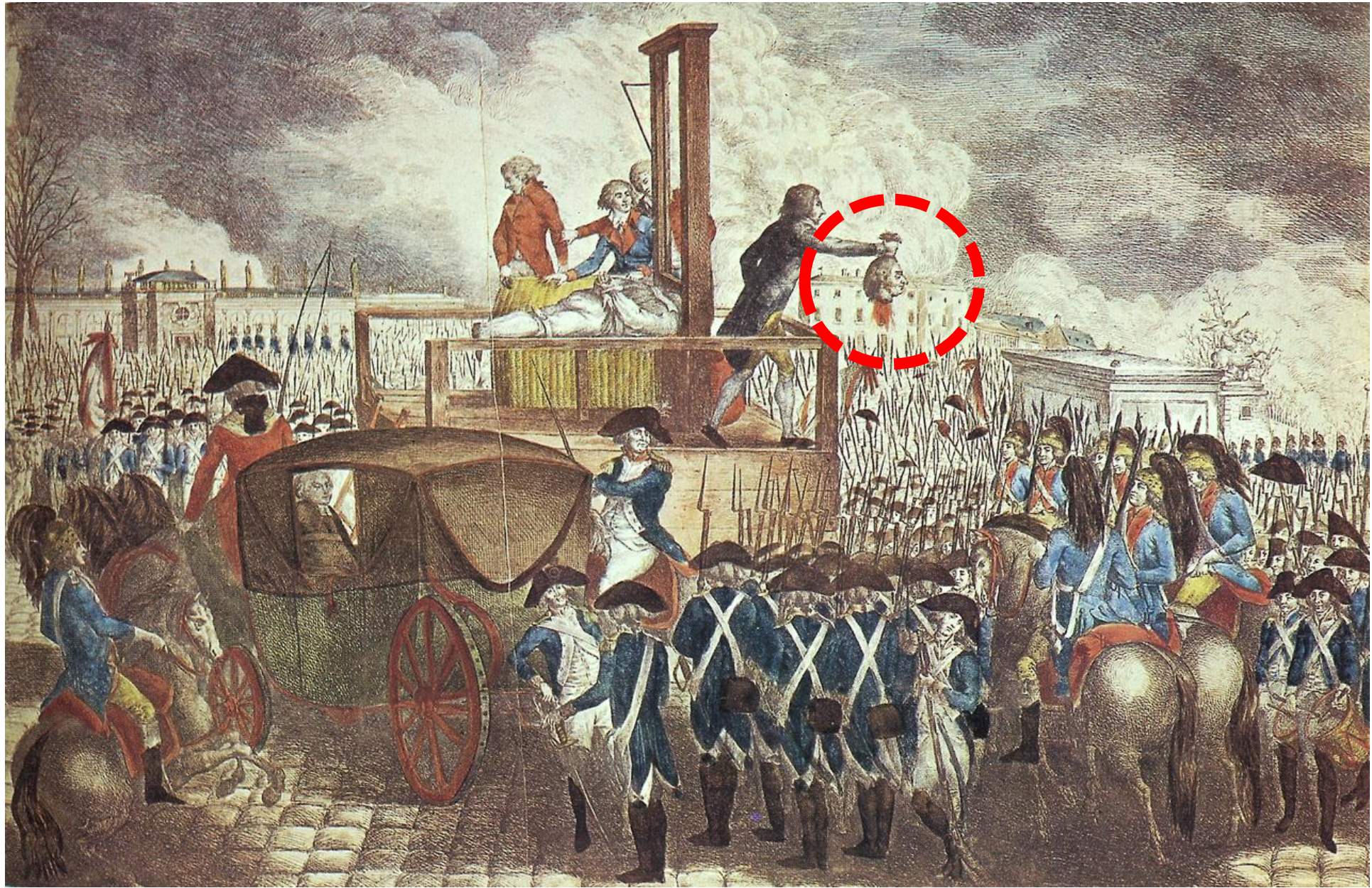

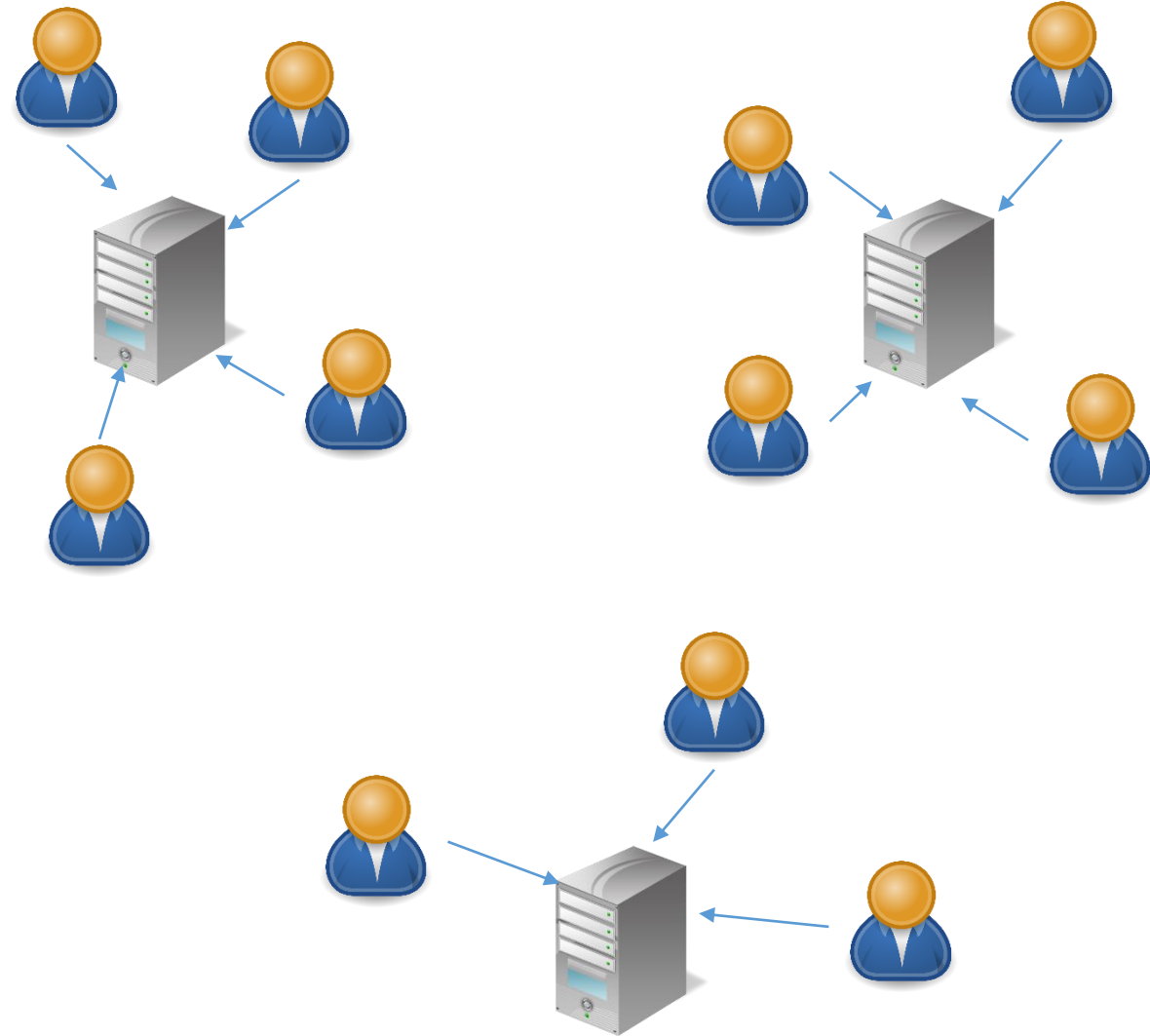

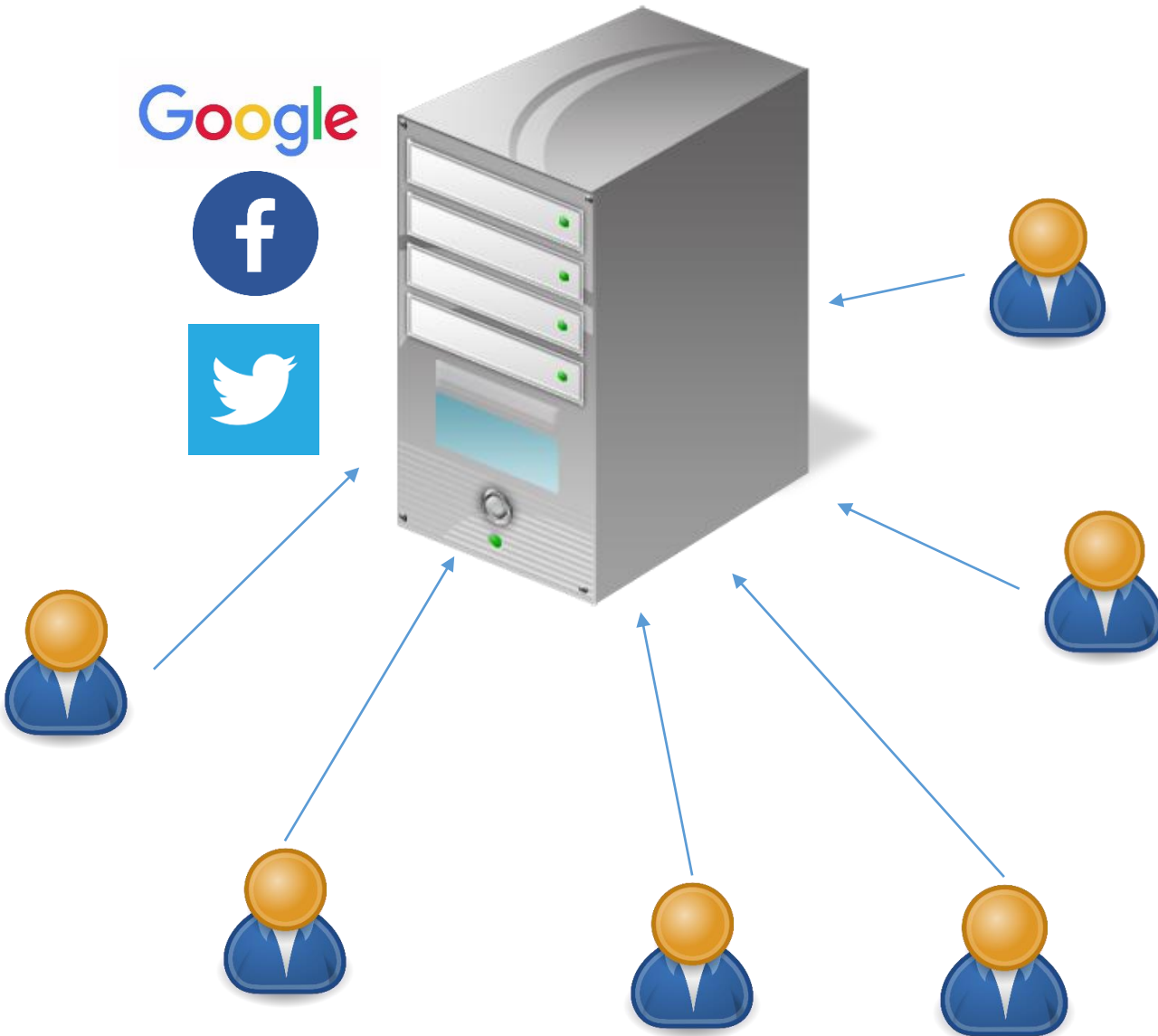


How *did* the web work?

worlds?!

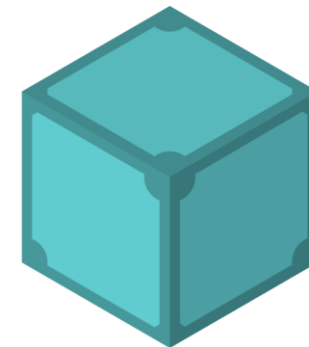


The “**Decentralised Web**” has many open-source implementations

Federated versions of popular services like Facebook, Twitter and YouTube

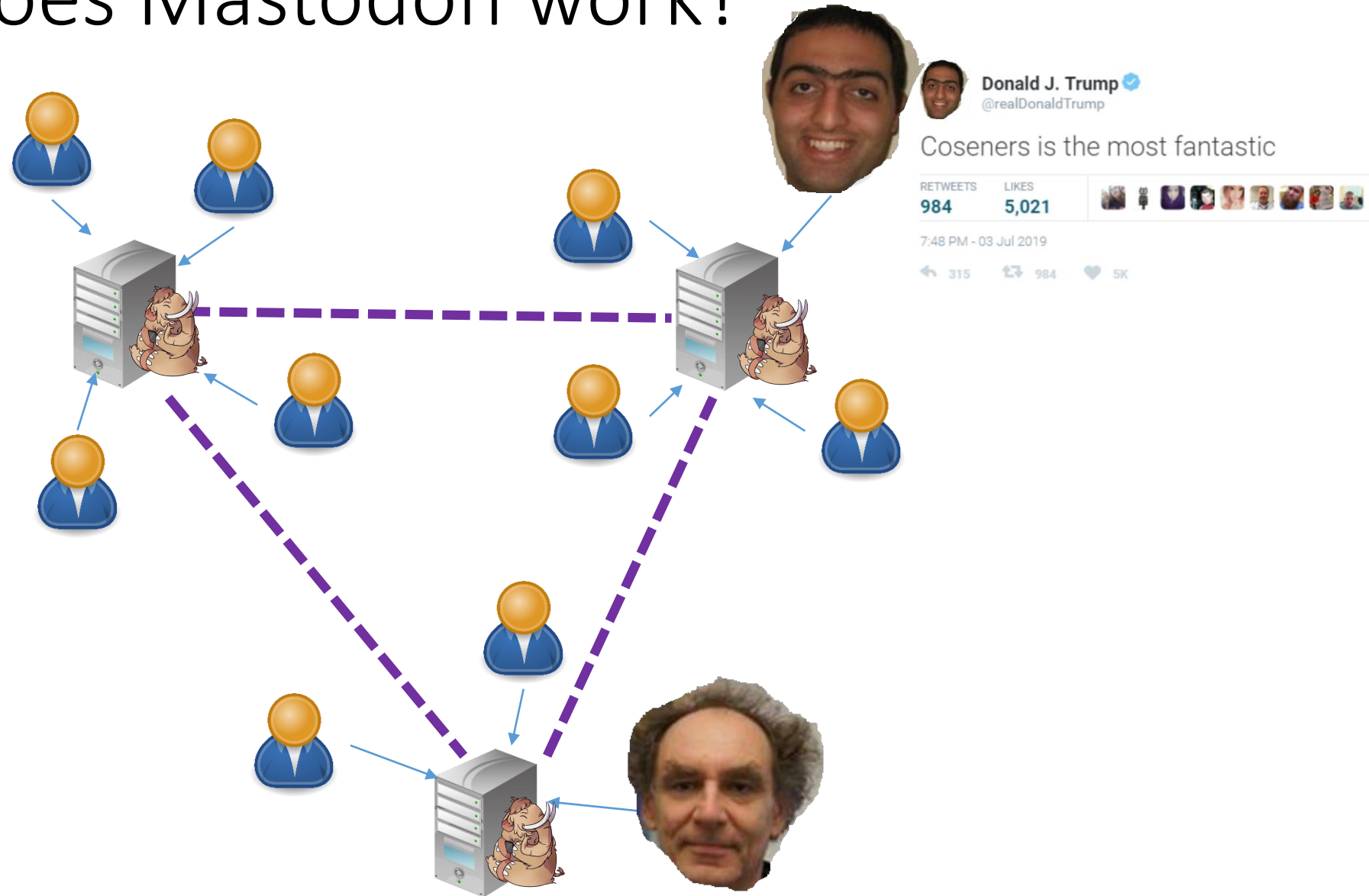

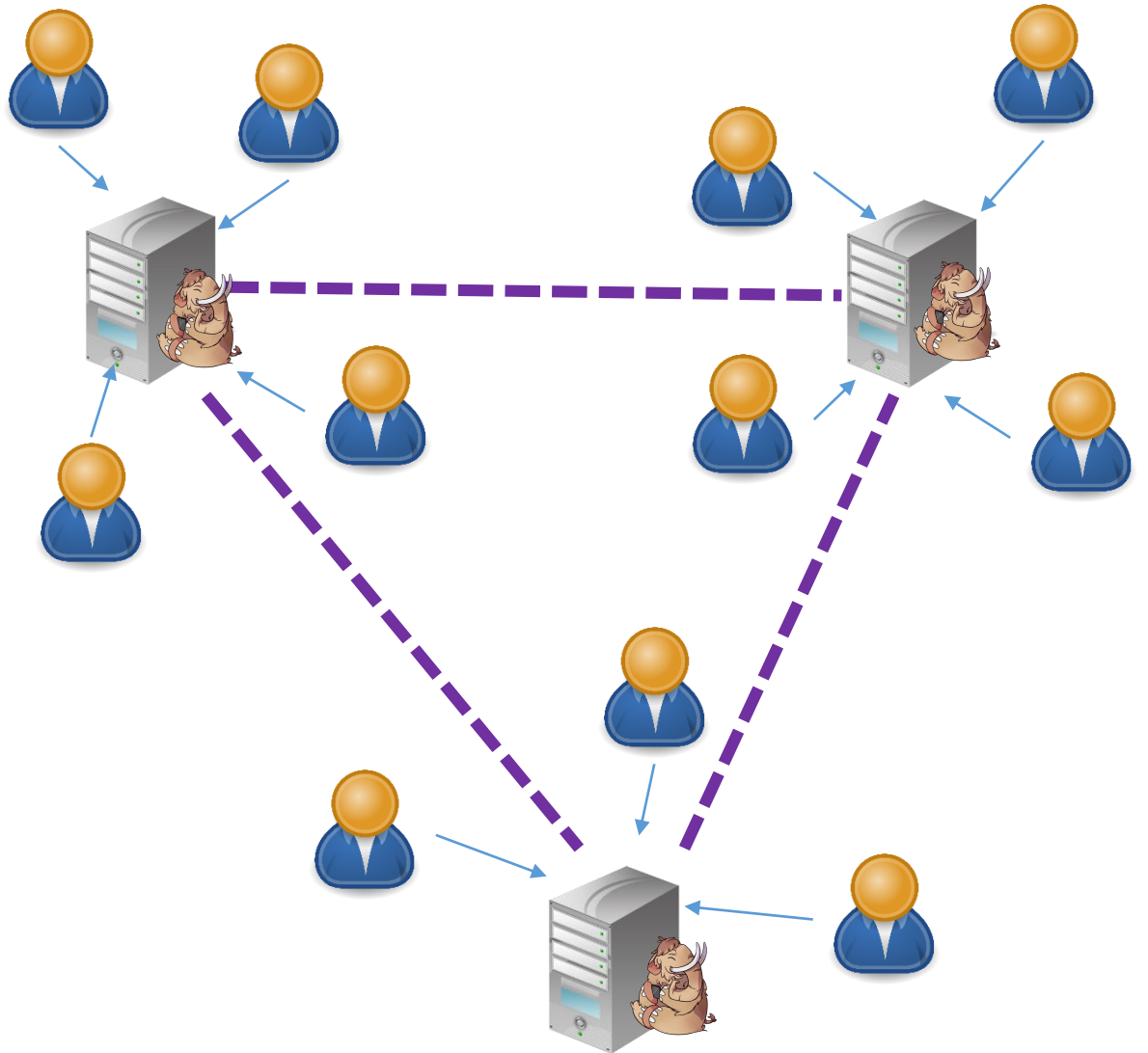

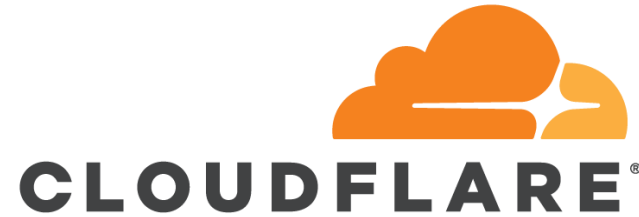
Let's measure Mastodon!

- “Decentralised Twitter”
 - Around 4K servers (aka “instances”)
 - 67M Mastodon “tweets”
- What pressures towards centralisation exist?



Let's go through a thought
experiment...

Where would you host your server?!



Half of users are reliant on just 3 networks!

...and 2/3 of content

Which instance would you join?!

90% of users join top 5% of the instances

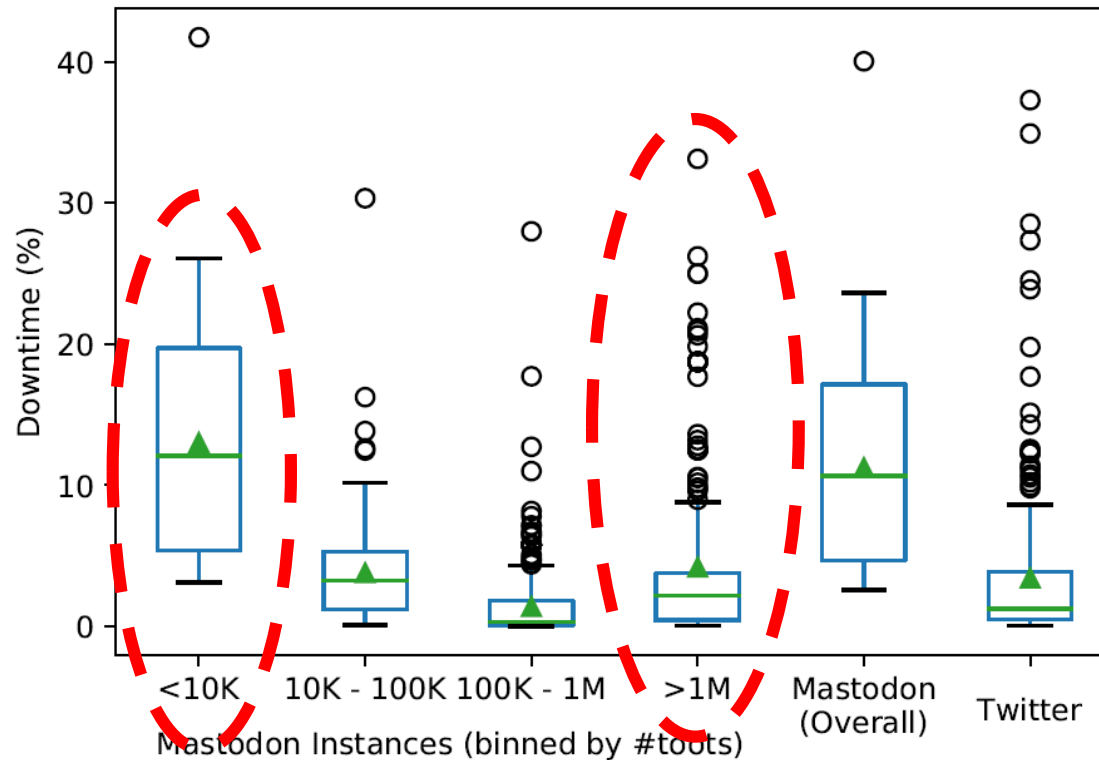


Linux

Top 5% of instances have 95% of content!

But at least decentralized == reliable?!

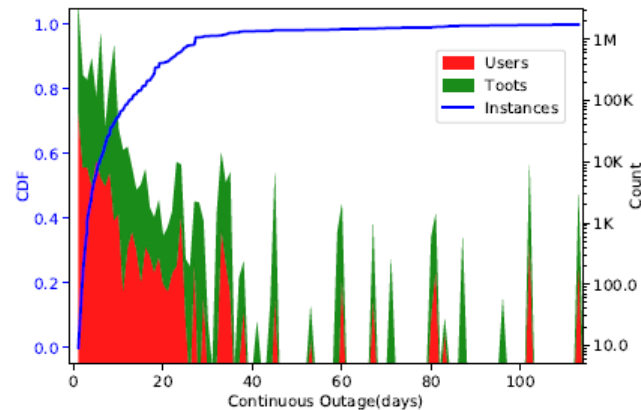
11% instances inaccessible for half of time



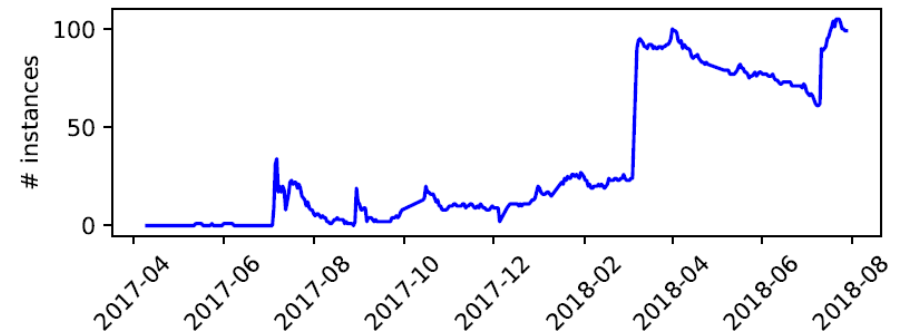
But at least decentralized == reliable?!

...still has central dependencies!



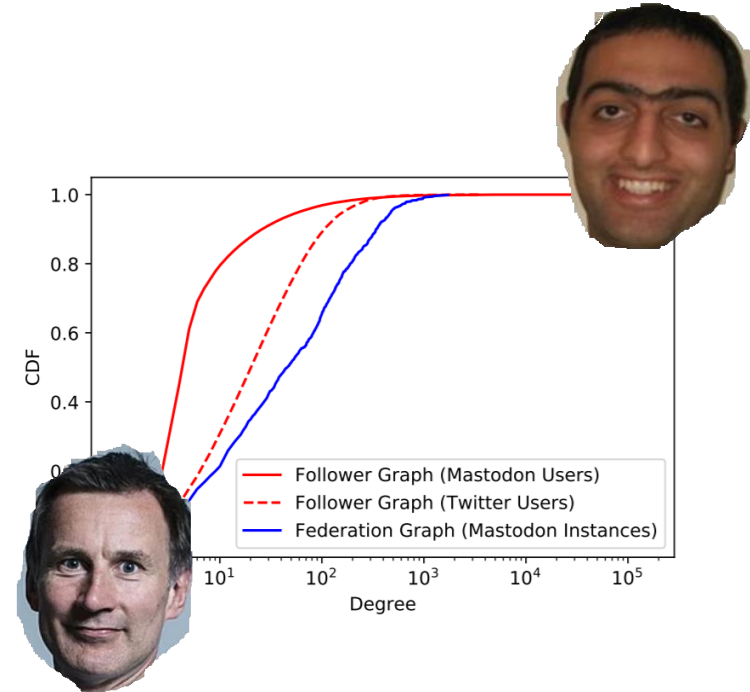
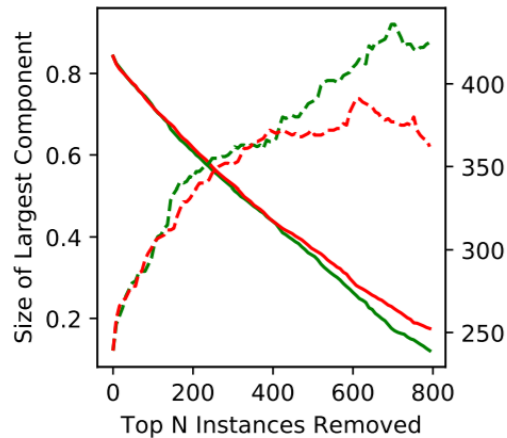
